#### Guilty until Proven Innocent:

A Race-Based Analysis of Exonerated Criminal Defendants in the United States and the Impact of Jury Bias and Eyewitness Testimony in Criminal Trials

Studies reveal that since 1989, nearly-balf of the 2,000 people exonerated for crimes in the Unitate Stare black (Gross, et. al., 2017). My research examines whether racial bias in the American criminal justice syst contributes to innocent black defendants being found guilty of criminal offenses more often than innocent wh defendants.
